

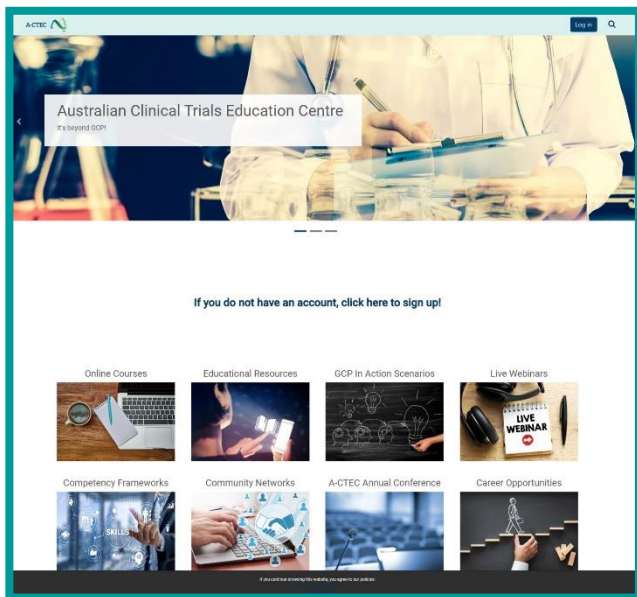


A-CTEC Registration and Access Instructions

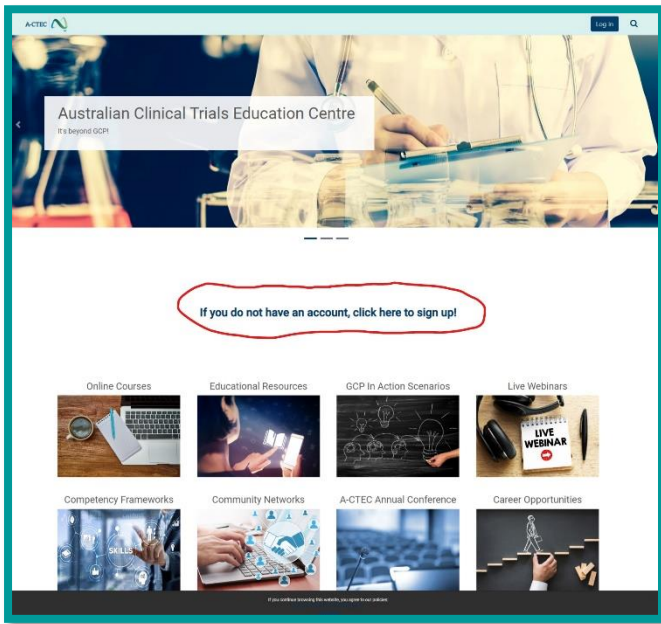

1. To register to A-CTEC and gain access to the platform, please enter website address in your browser.

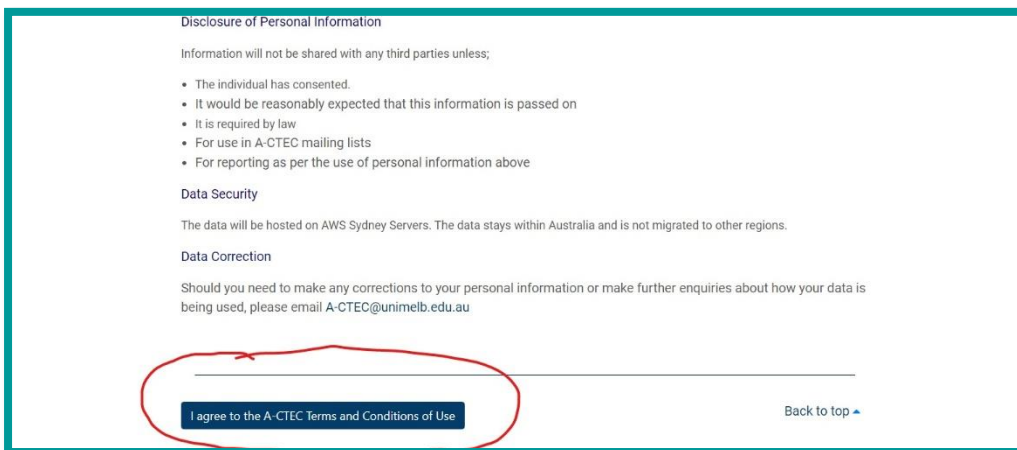
This is what the A-CTEC home page looks like when you are not logged in or do not have a registered account:



2. Click on the 'If you do not have an account, click here to sign up!' button



3. You will then need to agree to A-CTEC's Terms and Conditions of Use before proceeding.



*You may notice a little pop-up at the bottom of the screen saying 'If you continue browsing this website, you agree to our policies' with a link to our Terms and Conditions of Use as well. Clicking 'Continue' will make this pop-up disappear.

4. Once you have agreed to A-CTEC's Terms and Conditions of Use, you will be taken to the New Account Creation page.

Fill in the required sections of the page and answer the security question before clicking the 'Create my new account' button.

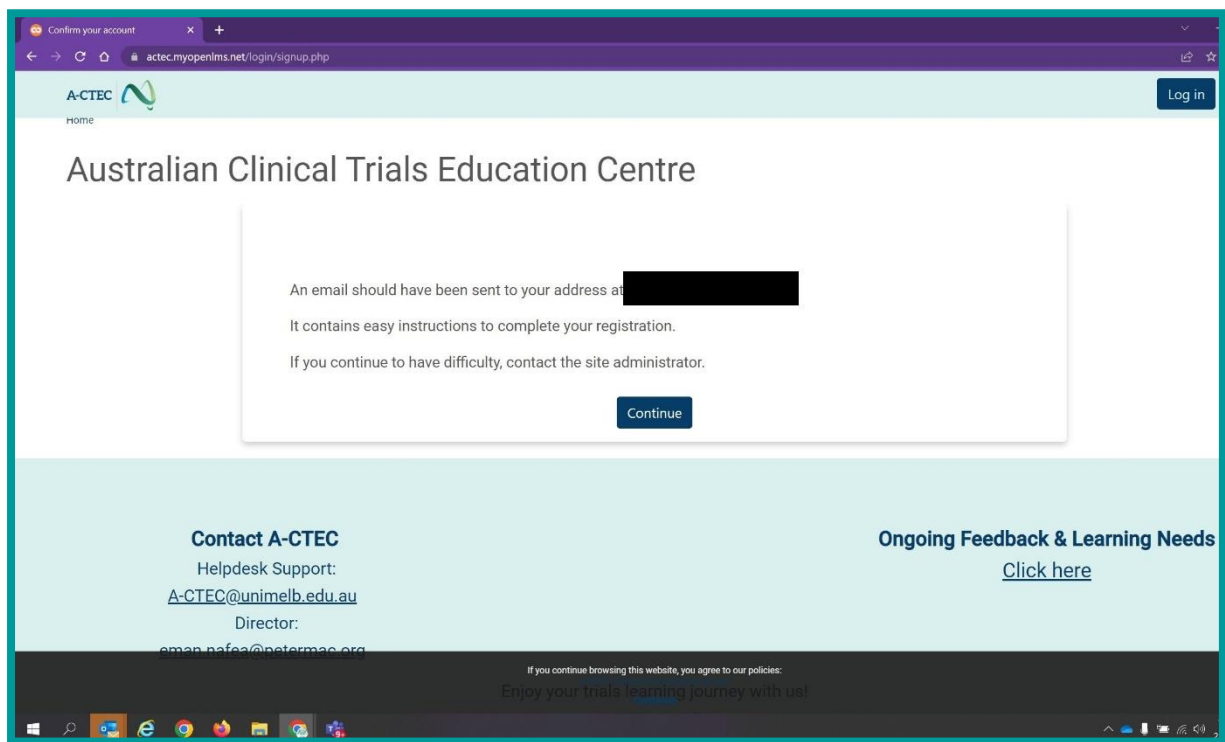

5. Once you have created your new account, you will see this message



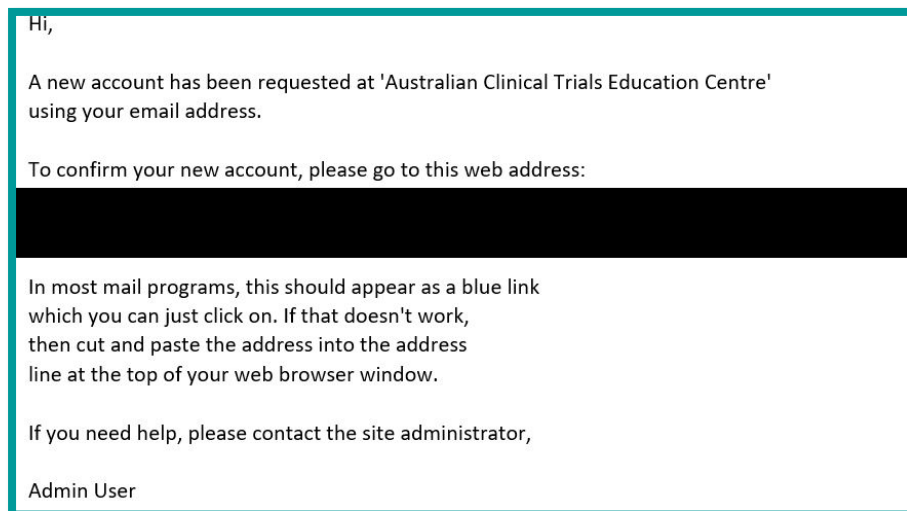
It can take up to 5 minutes for the confirmation email to come through to your nominated email address.

Importantly, your organisation's email filters can also stop the email from arriving in your inbox.

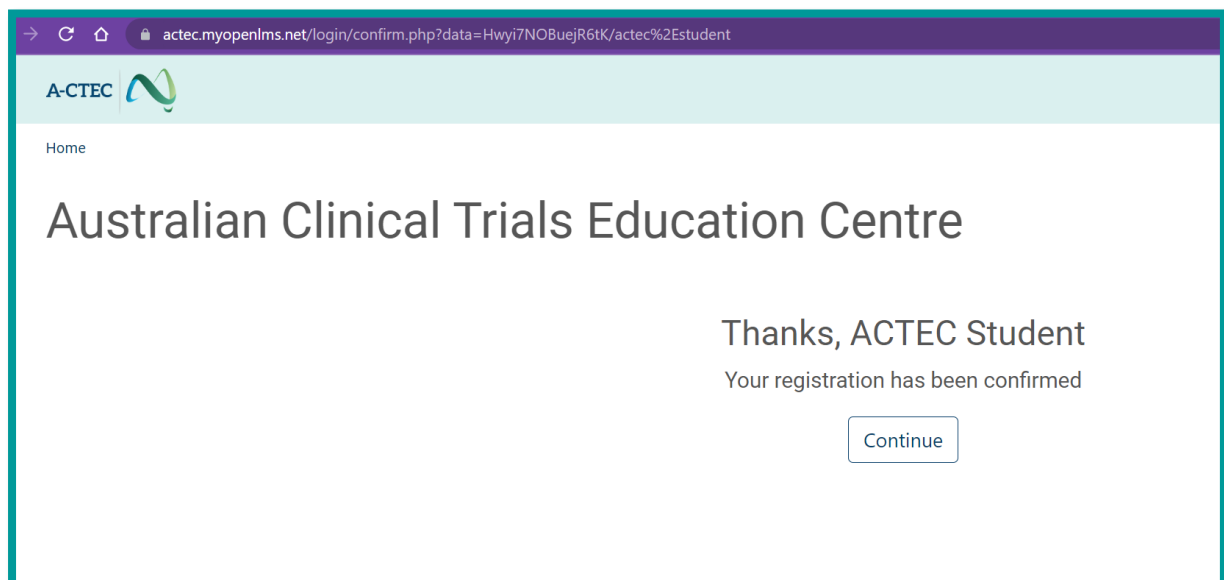
In the event that it has been more than 5 minutes since you signed up and the confirmation email has not arrived, contact your organisation's IT team.

When you contact your organisation's IT team for assistance, you may advise them that the email is an automatically generated from the LMS which is Moodle based, so the email address it will come from is noreply@mrooms.net

The confirmation email looks like this:

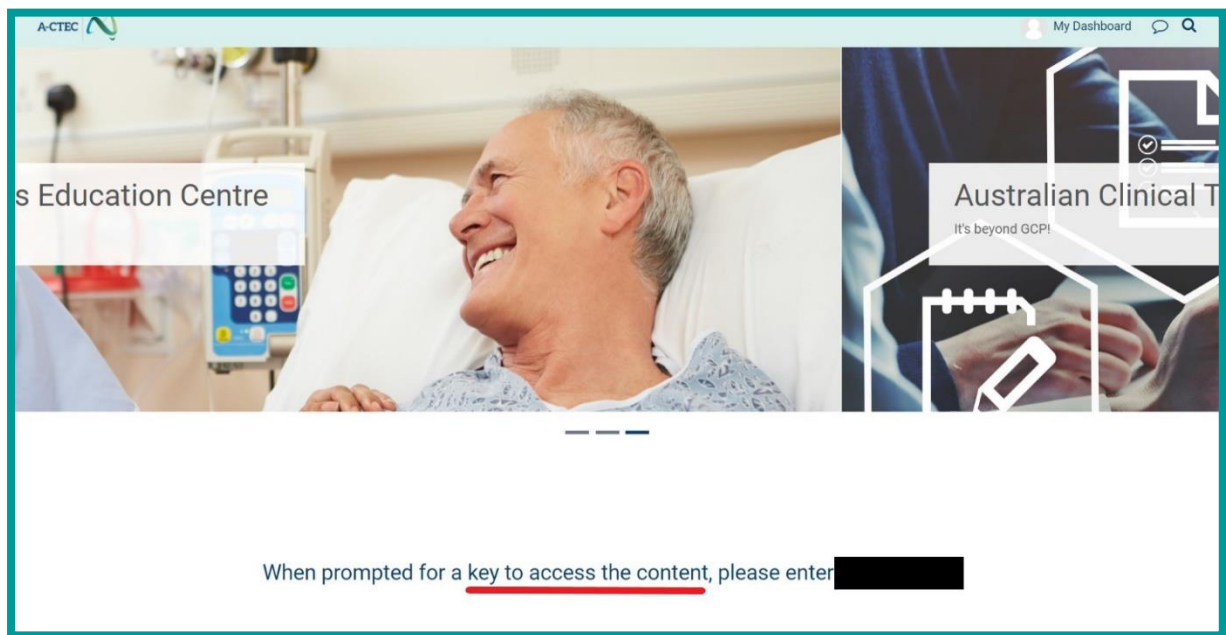


6. Once you click the link in the confirmation email, this message will come up on the platform



You will now be able to access the A-CTEC platform through your registered account.

The home page will now look like this



There will be a short tour and then you will be free to browse

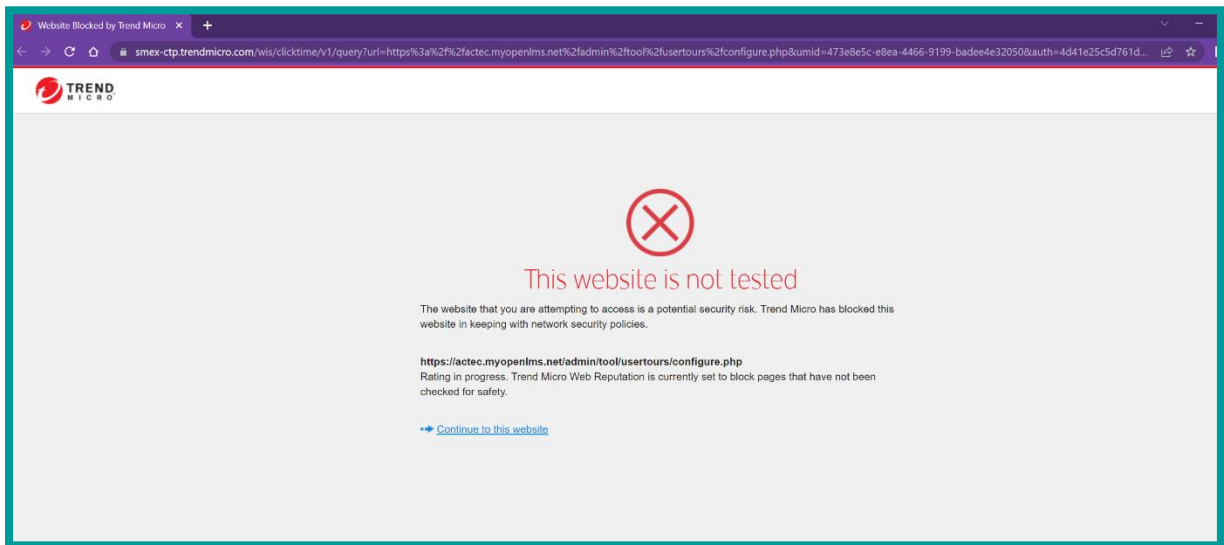
7. To access courses and other content on A-CTEC, you will need to enter the access key

The access key, as you can see above, is listed on the home page of the A-CTEC platform

IT Troubleshooting:

You may receive an error message that looks something like this:

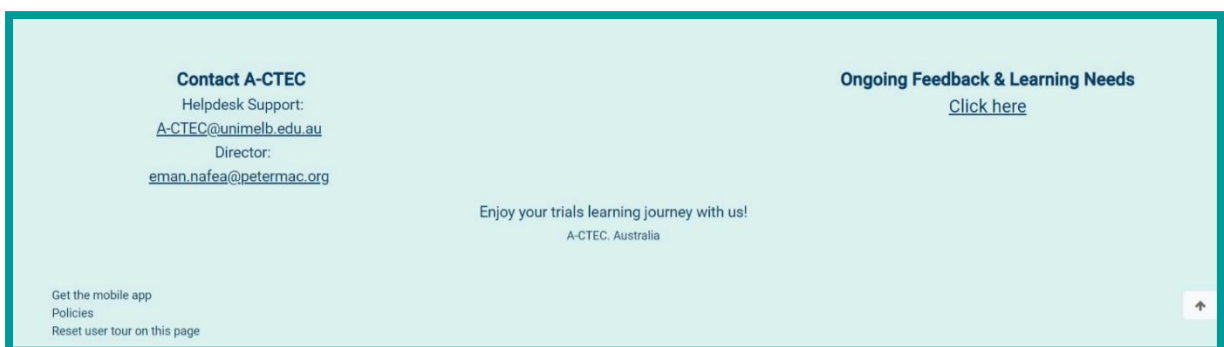


We can confirm that it is safe to click through the platform.
